

MOSES AND THE BURNING BUSH

FAMILY DEVOTION

11 But Moses said to God, “Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?” 12 And God said, “I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain.”

Exodus 3:11-12

"Who am I, Lord?" We all ask this question sometimes. Sometimes we don't feel equipped or able to do the things that God asks of us. In this story, Moses asks the same question. He doesn't know what gifts he has to offer in helping God's people and he is not confident in his ability to rescue God's people from Egypt.

Remember last week when we talked about how each of us have special gifts to offer the body of Christ? Moses may not have been sure of his special gift but God knew Moses was the one he wanted to lead his people to the promised land. Even though Moses may not have been seen as the strongest or best man for the job by himself or those around him, God chose him and equipped him for the work he was called to do. God reminded him that he has the Holy Spirit with him. With God, all things are possible. And Moses was able to rescue God's people with the help of God and his faith in God.
