FAMILY DEVOTION

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Galatians 5:22-23

The words listed above are words we are all familiar with. We hear them often from our ministers, our parents, our friends and even on decorative signs or posters.
